- Howmet Aerospace (formerly Arconic Engines, Alcoa Forgings and Extrusions, Firth Rixson), a forged metal products manufacturer, in a 220,000 SF facility
- Target operates a 1.5 million SF regional DC
- The Tire Rack, a high-performance tire distributor, constructed a 242,000 SF (expandable) facility
- Pactra International Co. Ltd. / Hankook Tire leases a 502,854 SF spec. building for tire distribution in 10 states
- Western Power Sports, a motor-sports accessory distributor, opened a 240,00 SF DC in 2020
- Hooker Furnishings' HMI is in 1M SF of a 1,426,000 SF facility. Safavieh Furniture occupies the balance of the distribution center.
- Safavieh also has four building pads ranging in size from 200,000 to 1.2 million SF
- There are also three facilities under construction; 25,000 SF expandable for Palatize, an e-commerce retailer; 491,800 SF expandable for Seohan Auto Georgia, an auto parts manufacturer; and 350,000 SF for Creative Home Ideas, a home goods manufacturer and distributor.
