- TPW is also just south of Midway Industrial Park, where Hugo Boss and Balta Home USA have distribution centers, and SNF Floquip, Builders FirstSource, and Elan Technologies have manufacturing facilities.
- TPW is about four miles west of Tradeport East Business Center, where industry includes a 1.5 million

SF Target regional distribution center, as well as DCs for The Tire Rack, Western Power Sports and Pactra International Ltd. / Hankook Tires, Hooker Furnishings, and Safavieh Furniture as well as a manufacturing plant for Howmet Aerospace.
