## Location Benefits

- Less than two miles to I-95 via four-lane U.S. 84
- 25 miles to I-16, just 35 miles to Port of Savannah and 30 miles Savannah-Hilton Head International Airport
- 90 minutes to Jacksonville

## Current Tenants

- Elan Technology, a manufacturer of glass and ceramic insulators, operates a 75,000 SF facility
- Hugo Boss, a German-based manufacturer of upscale apparel and accessories, expanded its 165,000 SF distribution center to 330,000 total SF, and acquired an additional 287,000 SF building in 2023
- SNF Floquip, manufacturer of application machinery for polymers made by its parent SNF Holdings and used in water treatment, oil sands and mining industries, is in a 170,000 SF facility
- Builders FirstSource Truss Plant, manufactures custom wood roof trusses for residential and light commercial buildings in a 22,000 SF facility and is owned by a leading building products company
- Balta Home USA, a Belgian company that specializes in household goods especially carpeting, operates a 308,000 SF distribution center
- Marine Container South, part of Marine Container Services of New Jersey, operates a freight and warehouse business in a 47,599 SF facility
